









Lower Phase - Summer Term, 2023

Overview

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|  <p>Communication (tracking and motor skills)</p> | <p>This term pupils are exploring sensory texts such as Room on the Broom. They will be exploring the characters in the story and the adventures they have. Pupils will develop their fine motor and pre-writing skills linked to the stories we read. Pupils will also be engaging in interesting and fun activities designed to develop their tracking skills.</p> |
|  <p>Number and Measure.</p> | <p>In our Measure topic pupils are exploring Night and Day. They will be exploring the events of a day and routines that link to night time. Sequencing events and developing a knowledge of different day and night time activities. In Number work pupils are investigating all things number, through rhymes, songs and engaging practical activities. Pupils will develop their understanding of the sequence of number and explore objects of interest related to number.</p> |
|  <p>Let's Investigate</p> | <p>This term pupils are exploring how fast Teddy can travel. They will compare different methods of transport for teddy. We will encourage pupils to create the methods of transport and then test out their ideas to find out how fast teddy travels.</p> |
|  <p>Creative Art</p> | <p>In Art this term we are looking at natural art. Pupils will be exploring texture, colour and different natural objects. This also provides opportunity to explore and use our senses such as smell and touch.</p> |
|  <p>PSHE</p> | <p>In PSHE this term pupils will be exploring British Values including Respect. Initially pupils are looking at sharing activities with their peers and exploring different games. Then they will develop their understanding of respect through inclusion activities and role play areas.</p> |
|  <p>Music</p> | <p>This term we are exploring Japanese music. Pupils will be listening to music from around Japan, responding through exploration of different loud and quiet instruments and sounds. They will also explore different types of movements and breathing exercises.</p> |
|  <p>Physical Education</p> | <p>This term pupils will be exploring playgrounds and the skills required to use them such as climbing, running and sliding. We will be encouraging pupils to fully use equipment in playgrounds in school. Pupils will also be taking part in; to</p> |

Pupils will work together to move the ball in different ways to their peers.</p> <p>A small group of pupils will also access physical development at a local primary school to take part in Rugby Tots.</p> <p>Alongside our Physical Education lessons there will also be sessions for Rebound and Aquatic learning.</p> |
|  <p>Computing</p> | <p>This term pupils will be developing individual computing skills. Pupils will be using a one click mouse with a laptop, access devices to activate favoured items and creating simple cause and effects using the plasma screens. Pupils will also access the sensory suite and use the interactive equipment in there.</p> |
